ABOUT PRINTING INDUSTRY

Global printing industry reaches USD 760.6 billion in 2021 The USD 760.6-billion global print industry returns to growth in 2021 and is forecast to reach USD 834.3 billion in 2026, latest Smithers research finds Commercial, graphics, publications, packaging and label printing all face fundamental challenges in adjusting to the market space in the wake of Covid-19. The positive news – as outlined in the new Smithers report, *The Future of Global Printing to 2026* – is that after a highly disruptive 2020, markets have recovered across 2021; although this is not uniform across all segments. Total value of global printing will reach USD 760.6 billion in 2021, with the equivalent of 4.9 trillion A4 prints produced worldwide. This is up from USD 750.0 billion in 2020.


Packaging and label print have been far more resilient and provide a clear strategic focus for the industry moving forwards across the next five years. As a degree of stability returns to end-use markets, investment in new print and finishing equipment will be USD 15.9 billion this year.

Smithers anticipates that new demand in packaging and labels and in Asian growth economies will fuel a moderate increase through to 2026 – at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 1.9% by value, at constant prices.

Pakistan's estimated print market is around US \$ 7 billion. (Paper & Board US \$ 4.25 billion, Flexible US \$ 2.25 billion, Machineries & others US\$ 0.5 billion.)



Printing sector is the indirect partner of 6-7% (US \$ 2.5 billion) of Pakistan's total export which is around US \$ 35 billion by April still two more months to end of fiscal year.





PAPGAI provides the skilled workforce to the printing sector & creates the demand of high-end equipment which attract the international suppliers of equipment and consumables.


